



# ANTITRUST ENFORCEMENT AWARDS

## CALL FOR ENTRIES

The American Antitrust Institute invites legal practitioners and economists to submit entries for the AAI 2017 Antitrust Enforcement Awards.

Qualified nominations must relate to antitrust-focused litigation that was (a) initiated in or appealed in any U.S. state or federal court; and (b) resulted (whether or not subject to appeal) in a final judgment, verdict, dismissal, conviction, injunction, order, or settlement between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017.

The award submission period closes on July 15, 2017. The awards will be presented at a gala dinner on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 following the AAI's annual Private Enforcement Conference.

### ■ Outstanding Antitrust Litigation Achievement in Private Law Practice

This award is limited to private civil actions. Nominees can include a law firm, a law firm team, or individual practitioner(s). Nominees are judged on:

1. the benefit realized by the client, consumers, or class
2. the positive development of antitrust policy

### ■ Outstanding Antitrust Litigation Achievement by a Junior Lawyer

This award is limited to private civil actions. Nominees should be individual practitioner(s) under 40 years old or admitted to practice for 10 years or less. Nominees will be judged on:

1. the individual's contribution to the case
2. the benefit realized by the client, consumers, or class
3. the positive development of antitrust policy

### ■ Outstanding Antitrust Litigation Achievement in Economics

This award is limited to contributions within government or private civil or criminal antitrust litigation by an individual economist, team of economists, or economic consulting firm. Nominees are judged on:

1. contribution to the development of antitrust-related economic methodology, analysis, and/or presentation
2. the positive development of antitrust policy
